PATIENT BILL OF RIGHTS

THE PROVISIONS OF MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAW, "SECTION 111, CHAPTER 70E" APPLY TO BOSTON SPORTS MEDICINE.

- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO CONSIDERATE AND RESPECTFUL CARE
- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO COMPLETE, CURRENT AND UNDERSTANDABLE INFORMATION ON YOUR ILLNESS, POSSIBLE TREATMENTS, AND LIKELY OUTCOME FROM YOUR PHYSICIAN AND OTHER HEALTH PROFESSIONALS
- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO KNOW THE NAMES OF THE PEOPLE WHO TREAT YOU AND THEIR ROLES IN YOUR CARE, INCLUDING WHEN THOSE INVOLVED ARE STUDENTS, RESIDENTS, AND OTHER TRAINEES
- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO CONSENT TO OR REFUSE TREATMENT
- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO HAVE AN ADVANCE DIRECTIVE, SUCH AS A HEALTH CARE PROXY
- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO PRIVACY
- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO ACCESS YOUR MEDICAL RECORD AND CAN RECEIVE A COPY AT A REASONABLE FEE
- IF YOU ARE ASKED TO PARTICIPATE IN A RESEARCH STUDY, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO CONSENT OR DECLINE
- YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO PROMPT AND ADEQUATE RESPONSE, WITHIN OUR CAPACITY TO ALL REASONABLE REQUESTS

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
